# PROCUREMENT OFFICER'S DETERMINATION INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING CONTRACT NO. 221029-H REPLACEMENT OF SPECIALTY SECURITY CAMERAS

## I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Determination has been executed pursuant to COMAR 21.05.09, Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing, to procure Specialty Security Cameras for the MDOT MPA under an Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement of the Department of Information Technology (DOIT), Hardware 2012 Master Contract No. 060B2490022, Functional Area VI and to recommend a contract award to EN-NET SERVICES, L.L.C. ("ENNET Services") in the amount of \$133,514.47. This solicitation was designated as a Small Business Reserve (SBR) contract.

### III. BACKGROUND

The Maryland Department of Transportation, Maryland Port Administration (MDOT MPA) is purchasing new Specialty Security Cameras to replace the existing Wide Area View (WAV) cameras that were installed in 2012-13 and reached end of hardware life of part of its equipment.

Below is a detailed list of the equipment being purchased.

Three (3) SBR Master Contractors were solicited via DOIT's Hardware 2012 Master Contract No. 060B2490022 on May 27, 2021, and one (1) proposal were received on June 3, 2021. The firms who did not submit a quote was requested to complete a NO BID form however, no responses were received.

The MDOT MPA Information Services Department has deemed "ENNET Services" financial proposal fair and reasonable and recommends the vendor for award. I concur with the recommendation of ISD.

# IV. DETERMINATION

Executive Director

- A. The DOIT Hardware 2012 Master Contract meets the requirements of an intergovernmental cooperative purchasing agreement under COMAR 21.05.09.01B(2)(a).
- B. "ENNET Services" price represents a savings of \$131,203.53 over the manufacturer's AXIS suggested retail price for the cameras. Therefore, it is in the best interest of the State for MDOT MPA to utilize the DOIT contract because doing so will provide cost benefits to the State, will promote administrative efficiencies, and is not intended to evade the purposes set forth under COMAR 21.01.01.03.
- C. The award amount is within the funding available.
- D. A contract should be awarded to EN-NET SERVICES, L.L.C in the amount of \$133,514.47 for the purchase of the Specialty Security Cameras.
- E. Since this procurement constitutes a procurement of information technology supplies for which MDOT MPA has an unlimited delegation of procurement authority from the Board of Public Works (the "BPW"), approval of the award by the Maryland Port Commission and the BPW are not required.
