I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Securitas Technology Corporation (Securitas TC) is the awardee of Contract No. 517811, procured by the Maryland Port Administration (MPA), under an Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement of the Maryland Department of Information Technology (DOIT) Hardware 2012 Master Contract.

II. BACKGROUND

Modification No. 8 extends the contract from June 1, 2024 through September 30, 2024. The cost of this extension for the warranty and maintenance is \$4,235.12 for a total revised contract amount of \$199,456.54. This modification is needed because the MPA is migrating to a Genetec system and until that migration is completed the MPA needs the Lenel system maintained under Contract No. 517811.
