Directions to the Maryland Department of Transportation:

If walking, biking, or rolling: Bikes can be stored directly in the MDOT Headquarters. The building can be accessed via Corporate Center Drive, or by navigating to the BWI Rail Station on the BWI Trail and using the elevated boardwalk connecting it to MDOT (see transit instructions). Use your preferred map/app to plan your route, or consult MDOT's [level of traffic stress map](#).

If taking transit: The BWI Rail MARC Station is a short walk (under 10 minutes) away from the MDOT building. The station is serviced by the MARC Penn line, which connects D.C. and Baltimore with intermittent stops. Maryland commuter bus routes 201 and 210 also connect to the BWI Rail MARC Station. At the station, enter the pedestrian bridge and head to the Track 3 side (further from the parking lot), which connects with an elevated walkway that will take you straight to MDOT Headquarters.

If driving: Free parking is available in the lot off of Corporate Center Drive, which is directly across from MDOT on the opposite side of the road. Please do not park in either of the lots directly in front of building (these are reserved for employees).
