

# Climate Focused Funding Portal

In Maryland, the transportation sector is the largest source of greenhouse gas emissions. Climate change is already beginning to impact the Maryland transportation network, including increased temperatures leading to delays for rail service, increased flooding on roadways and bridges, and damage to transportation infrastructure and services caused by severe storms. MDOT understands the importance of investing in transportation projects that have climate benefits and is launching the Climate Focused Funding Portal. This portal will support identification and implementation of these important projects.

The Climate Focused Funding Portal's current priority is the solicitation of decarbonization projects for funding available through the federal Carbon Reduction Program. Eligible projects include public transportation, intelligent transportation systems, efficient lighting and traffic controls, transportation demand management, diesel engine retrofits, deployment of alternative fuel vehicles, and more!
