What is "Complete Streets?"

- An approach to plan, design, and construct streets that are safe for all users, ages, & abilities
- Emphasizes needs of underserved and vulnerable users











Objectives



Safety – Complete streets prioritize safety for vulnerable users.

Connectivity – Complete streets supports connected networks.

Equity – Complete streets emphasize engagement with underserved populations.

Climate – Complete streets encourage mode shift by investing in infrastructure for low and no-carbon travel.

MDOT is developing new programs to advance environment and sustainable transportation.

MDOT is making Complete Streets the default approach and redesigning corridors for cars into streets for people.
