

The 2050 Maryland Transportation Plan (MTP)

The MTP examines the state's most critical transportation needs and challenges, provides a framework for statewide goals and objectives, and identifies strategies to help the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) meet the goals and objectives. The MTP is performance-based, which means it uses measures to help gauge progress toward the goals and objectives. These measures are developed in tandem with the MTP as part of MDOT's annual Attainment Report (AR) on Transportation System Performance. The MTP's 20-year vision informs Maryland's Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP), which programs funding for individual transportation investments in a six-year budget. All three of these reports comprise the annual State Report on Transportation. The MTP also informs, and is informed by, various plans, reports, and frameworks which the Maryland Department of Transportation produces for freight, rail, transit, the port, airport, highways, tolls, bridges/tunnels, pedestrian/bicycles, and motor vehicles.
