Transportation Alternatives
(TA) is a competitively selected reimbursable federal-aid program that is administered by the State Highway Administration. TA funds feasibility studies, design projects, construction projects, and non-infrastructure projects that create bicycle and pedestrian facilities, restore historic transportation buildings, convert abandoned railway corridors to pedestrian trails and mitigate highway runoff.

Eligible Applicants: local governments, regional transportation authorities, transit agencies, natural resource and public land agencies, school districts and local education agencies, tribal governments, 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations.

Any other local and governmental entity with oversight of transportation or recreational trails (other than a metropolitan planning organization or a State agency).
