PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming approve and forward to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for its approval the following STIP amendments.

SUMMARY

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP to reflect the following five actions.

ANALYSIS

eConstruction Construction Change Order Automation (AI2201) – This requested amendment reflects the addition to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP of a new project, AI2201, and the addition of \$550,000 to AI2201 funding. This project enables MDOT SHA to fund development and accelerate deployment to automate and streamline MDOT SHA's construction change order process with the objective of generating a tool within MDOT SHA's eConstruction platform specifically process change orders to decrease paperwork, more effectively track change orders, and eliminate errors. The funding added by this amendment covers MDOT SHA's programmed expenditures in FY 2022-2023.

Work Zone Data Exchange Demonstration (AT020G) – This requested amendment reflects the addition to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP of a new project, AT020G, and the addition of \$250,000 to AT020G funding. This project enables MDOT SHA to publish a new work zone data exchange (WZDx)-compliant data feed in RITIS and will expand the quality of data that is sent to transportation stakeholders including private sector and media traveler information providers and state and local agencies' ATMS platforms. The funding added by this amendment covers MDOT SHA's programmed expenditures in FY 2022.

Highway or Capital Transit Construction Training and Supportive Services Program (AX9917) – This requested amendment reflects the addition to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP of a new project, AX9917, and the addition of \$800,000 to AX9917 funding. As required under Maryland Transportation Code §8-508, this project enables MDOT SHA to develop, conduct, and administer highway or capital transit construction training and support services, including skill improvement programs, to the greatest extent feasible to individuals in each relevant workforce development area. The funding added by this amendment covers MDOT SHA's programmed expenditures in FY 2022-2024.

SWMFAC Data Portal and Operations Manual (AZ1422) – This requested amendment reflects the addition to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP of a new project, AZ1422, and the addition of \$160,000 to AZ1422 funding. This project enables MDOT SHA to develop a data sharing portal for stormwater management facility maintenance data that will coordinate and feed MDOT SHA Operations and Maintenance Manual applications for field maintenance technician use in the field. The funding added by the amendment covers MDTO SHA's programmed expenditures in FY 2022-2023.

Maryland FY 2022 Freight Plan (FP2201) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project, FP2201, to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP and includes \$28,450,000 in NHFP and matching State funding for a series of freight-related initiatives in FY 2022-2026. Specifically, the project adds \$2,350,000 to planning funding, \$4,300,000 to design funding, and \$21,800,000 to construction funding for FP2201 in the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP. Initiatives include:

- Design and construction of additional truck parking at the I-70 Welcome Center
- Calibration and validation enhancements for modeling freight in line with FHWA's C20 Program
- Truck-specific and freight CAV-related enhancements to the Maryland Statewide Travel Model
- MDOT SHA's freight AV implementation plan
- MDOT SHA's freight EV charging pilot program
- Statewide truck stop technology enhancements
- Development of a single digital data exchange platform to support data collection and hosting for real-time freight transportation information
- Virtual weigh station RITIS software and hardware upgrades
- Truck scale house static scale upgrades

The attached STIP reports document MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above projects. These requested actions will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. MDOT published funding details in the draft FY 2022-2027 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
