PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request OPCP notify the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) of the amendment to the FY 22-25 STIP. This amendment adds \$2.0 million in 5339 funding and \$512K in state/local funding (increase of \$542K in local funding and a decrease of \$30K in state) to FY 24.

SUMMARY

The MTA requests the FY22-25 STIP to reflect the following action.

ANALYSIS

The 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities project provides capital funding to replace, rehabilitate, and purchase buses and related equipment and to make bus facility improvements in rural areas. This amendment will allow for the replacement of (4) 60' articulated buses, (10) small buses, (2) sedans, and a new bus shelter. The amendment adds \$2.0 million in 5339 funds and \$512K in state/local match. The total project cost is now \$8.5million.
