SUMMARY

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP to reflect the following action.

State Planning Work Program (SP2501) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of SHA's \$64.2 million FY 2025 State Planning Work Program (Part 1) to the FY 2022-2025 STIP. The work program will be funded with State Transportation Trust Fund, federal Statewide Planning (SP), federal Safe and Accessible Transportation Options (Safe Access), and federal Surface Transportation Block Grant funding, as well as toll credit match in the amount of \$12.1M. This project enables SHA to cooperatively, continuously, and comprehensively make transportation investment decisions and coordinate transportation planning activities throughout Maryland. The State Planning Work Program (Part 1) supports strategic and systems planning, data collection and analysis, and special studies. The funding added by this amendment covers SHA's programmed activities for FY 2025.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2024-2029 Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP.
