Dear Mr. Anderson:

The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) has requested approval of an Amendment to the FY 2022-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (Control #22-176 dated December 2, 2024), to include one new project: The “Capital 5307 and 5339 Small Urban Transit System – Allegany County”, programming \$300,000 of 5307 funds for obligation in FY 2025.

Based on our review of the information provided, the FTA has determined this is an Administrative Modification and is not subject to Federal approval. The project was previously programmed on the MD STIP with the incorporation of the Cumberland Area Metropolitan Planning Organization FY 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which included \$298,000 of Section 5307 funding programmed in FY2025 for this project. The requested change to the STIP is a technical correction and minor adjustment of funding below the threshold requiring Federal approval.
