The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2025 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect changes to the MD 231 Geometric Improvements along MD 231 at MD 508 (CA2761) project on behalf of the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA). The SHA requests this amendment in order that the STIP reflects SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and overall project schedule.

PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT OPPPD approve and forward to the Federal Highway Administration for its approval the following STIP amendment.

SUMMARY

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP to reflect the following one action.

ANALYSIS

MD 231 Geometric Improvements at MD 508 (CA2761) – This amendment reflects the addition to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP of the addition of \$829,000 in design funding. In addition, SHA is decreasing right-of-way funding by \$300,000 and a decrease of \$2,917,000 in utility funding. The SHA requests this amendment in order that the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP reflects SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule. The design of this project is wholly federally funded as SHA will use toll credits to convert the required state match funding component to federal funds. The total estimated cost is \$14,199,000 and SHA anticipates starting construction in the Spring of 2027.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above projects. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid. This project was funded as part of the \$900M+ in additional federal formula funding provided by IIJA over the previous federal transportation act.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2022-2027 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).

Smart Zone Speed Management (AZ3751) – This amendment reflects the addition of \$524,000 in design funding to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP of the addition. The SHA requests this amendment in order that the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP reflects SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule. The design of this project is wholly federally funded as SHA received a SMART federal grant. The total estimated cost is \$1,610,001.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above projects. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion
