PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT OPPPD request C-SMMPO to approve the following TIP amendment and, upon C-SMMPO approval, notify the Federal Highway Administration - Maryland Division of the amendment to the C-SMMPO FY 2025 – FY 2028 TIP.

SUMMARY

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP to reflect the following two actions.

ANALYSIS

MD 4 Corridor Improvements (S-2018-07) – This requested amendment reflects the transfer of \$2,000,000 to FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP design funding for S-2018-07. Of the \$2,000,000, \$1,000,000 has been allocated to SHA through the federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022, and \$1,000,000 is being reallocated by MDOT from FY 2024 to FY 2026 to support design studies through FY 2026. The SHA requests this amendment in order that the FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP reflects SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule in FY 2025-2030. Full design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction funding for the full corridor (estimated at approximately \$800 million) remains to be identified.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) reports document MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above projects. These requested actions will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the draft FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program

(https://www.mdot.maryland.gov/OPCP/CTP_2025/FY25_FY30_CTP_Full_Report_Regular_Resolution _for_viewing.pdf) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
