# **ANALYSIS**

*I-795:* Dolfield Boulevard Interchange (BRTB 63-0803-46) – This requested administrative modification will add \$3,266,000 in PE funding to the FY 2025-2028 BRTB TIP. The project will improve overall network safety and mobility along I-795, and will improve safety and connections for vulnerable users along Dolfield Boulevard. The total cost of the project is estimated to be \$146,920,000. This project is

currently in design, which is approaching the semi-final milestone in March 2025, and is anticipated to be completed in Winter 2027/2028. This project is currently not funded for construction. Once funded, construction is anticipated to begin in Summer 2028, and be completed in Fall 2032.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested administrative modification with respect to funding for the project above. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The modified funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2025-2028 Consolidated Transportation Program and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP.
