The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby modifies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2025 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect changes to one existing project in the FY 2023-2026 National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on behalf of the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT).

This action updates the programmed expenditures of the North Bethesda Metro Station Improvements project from FY 2022 to FY 2025, shifting the \$5 million of Congressional Community Project Funding from FY 2025 to FY 2026. This administrative modification has been assigned MDOT Control #22-236, and this project does not affect the Air Quality Conformity Determination for Visualize 2045.
