ANALYSIS

MD 91: Bridge Replacements over the North Branch of the Patapsco River and the Maryland Midland Railroad (BRTB 64-2201-13) — This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project to the FY 2022-2025 BRTB TIP. The project will add \$788,000 in design funding, \$74,000 in right-of-way acquisition funding, and \$10,475,000 in construction funding to the FY 2022-2025 BRTB TIP. The project includes replacing MDOT SHA bridge 06020 over the North Branch of the Patapsco River and MDOT SHA bridge 06047 over the Maryland Midland Railroad. MDOT SHA estimates the total cost will be \$11,347,000 and that construction will be completed in 2024.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2022-2027 Consolidated Transportation Program (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/Index.html) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/STIP TIP/STIPandTIP.html).
