PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming notify the FHWA Maryland Division of this administrative modification.

SUMMARY

On March 4, 2022, Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Department of Transportation Planning (MWCOG DTP) staff approved the following MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA)-requested administrative modification to the FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP.

ANALYSIS

MD 4 at Suitland Parkway Interchange Construction (TPB 3547) – This administrative modification reflects the conversion of \$20.3 million in programmed federal NHPP funding to federal NHFP funding for TPB 3547 construction in the FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP. This modification also reflects the addition of \$8.1 million in federal NHPP funds to FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP construction funding for TPB 3547. This administrative modification ensures the FY 2021-2024 TPB TIP reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule in FY 2021-2024. This project's estimated total cost is increasing from \$208 million to \$217 million. Per the October 29, 2014, memorandum of

understanding executed by MDOT and the Federal Highway Administration, this action is eligible to be processed as an administrative modification as TPB 3547 is a \$10 million-plus project and this action constitutes an increase in total funding no greater than 20 percent of existing total project cost.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested modification with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The modified funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2022-2027 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
