PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming approve and forward to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for its approval the following STIP amendment.

SUMMARY

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP to reflect the following action.

OMT ARAN Pavement Network Condition Data Collection (AT4374) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project and \$800,000 to the FY 2022-2025 STIP, including Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funding as well as toll credits used to convert some State funding to federal funds. This project enables MDOT SHA to collect payment network condition data and ensure requirements are met to improve the quality of MDOT SHA data submitted to the Highway Performance Monitoring System (HPMS). Project activities will begin in the Summer of 2022 and continue through the Summer of 2023.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. MDOT published funding details in the FY 2022-2027 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
