AMENDMENT TO THE 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Hagerstown/Eastern Panhandle Metropolitan Planning Organization (HEPMPO) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Hagerstown-MD-WV-PA urbanized area and region, and includes official representatives of the cities of Hagerstown and Martinsburg, the towns of Washington County and of Berkeley County, the counties of Berkeley, Jefferson and Washington as well as representatives of the Maryland Department of Transportation, the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Washington County Transit, and the Eastern Panhandle Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Hagerstown/Eastern Panhandle Metropolitan Planning Organization, as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Hagerstown-MD-WV-PA urbanized area and region, approved the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program at its May 18, 2022 meeting, with federal concurrence received July 6, 2022; and

WHEREAS, federal regulations require that all transportation-related projects must be listed in the approved Transportation Improvement Program with accurate funding schedules in order to be eligible for federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Program consists of projects included in, and in support of, the region's long-range transportation plan and ongoing short-range planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration has requested approval of an amendment to the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program through the approved Transportation Improvement Program amendment process; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration is requesting to amend one project: (1) I-81 Interchange Improvements at Showalter Avenue (I-81 Phase 4B), Maugansville; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Program, as amended, continues to display financial reasonableness and re-affirms the appropriate project selection criteria whereby all requirements for a Transportation Improvement Program in the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act are met; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Transportation Improvement Program amendments were publicized for a 14-day review from October 5, 2022 to October 18, 2022. No comments were received on this project.

PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming approve and forward to HEPMPO for its approval the following TIP amendment.

SUMMARY

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2023-2026 HEPMPO TIP to reflect the following one action.

ANALYSIS

I-81 Interchange Improvements at Showalter Avenue (I-81 Phase 4B) (HEPMPO W2023-08) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project, W2023-08, to the FY 2023-2026 HEPMPO TIP and \$320,000 for design of W2023-08. The MDOT SHA requests this amendment so that the FY 2023-2026 HEPMPO TIP reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed expenditures and project schedule in FY 2023-2026. Remaining design is wholly federally funded as MDOT SHA will use toll credits to convert the State funding component to federal funds. In addition, this funding includes federal funds to cover federally funded overhead expenses. This project's total cost, including \$480,000 in State funding programmed and spent prior to the FY 2023-2026 HEPMPO TIP and the estimated cost of construction yet to be programmed, is \$9,800,000. The MDOT SHA anticipates completing design in 2023 and completing construction in 2025-2026.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the draft FY 2023-2028 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
