### PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming approve and forward to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for its approval the following STIP amendment.

#### **SUMMARY**

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests an amendment of the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP to reflect the following action:

## **ANALYSIS**

MD 367 Bishopville Prong Bridge Replacement (WO1241) – This amendment reflects the addition of a new project, WO1241, to the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP. The MDOT SHA requests this amendment in order that the FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP reflects this MDOT SHA's programmed project and project schedule in FY 2022-2025. This amendment adds \$2,124,000 in state and federal design funding. The project total estimated cost is \$7.4 million including an estimated \$5.0 million in construction, which is currently unfunded. Design is anticipated to begin in the Spring of 2023 and be completed by the Spring of 2026. Construction is anticipated to begin in the Spring of 2026 and be completed by the Spring of 2028.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above projects. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2022-2027 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
