MD 97 Reddy Branch Bridge Removal (TPB11623) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project to the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP and adds \$400,000 to the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP preliminary engineering funding for TPB 11623. This amendment ensures the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP reflects MDOT SHA updated programmed funds and project schedule in FY 2023-2026. The design is anticipated to be complete in 2024. The Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division (EFLHD) has developed the attached FY 2023 – FY 2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to describe those transportation projects that will be primarily implemented within the boundaries of the Federal Land Management Agency (FLMA) units located in your state.
