We have completed our review of the State request (MDOT Control #25-4) to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2028 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to add one new statewide project to the STIP and reflect changes to five rural and statewide projects on behalf of the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA).

- Statewide Stormwater Infrastructure Inspections – a new project (\$6.02M)
- Areawide Environmental Projects (\$15.58M)
- Areawide Congestion Management (\$2.23M)
- Areawide Resurfacing and Rehabilitation (\$9.5M)
- Areawide safety and Spot Improvements (\$17.1M)
- Coordinated Highway Action Response Team (CHART) (\$16.7M)

We accept this amendment and find that it was developed based on a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process, in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 134, 23 U.S.C. 135 and 49.
