The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby modifies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reflect the following administrative modification to the highway portion of the Salisbury/Wicomico Metropolitan Planning Organization (S/WMPO) FY 2019 – FY 2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The MDOT has designated this modification as Control #19-02.



PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming request SWMPO staff approve the following TIP administrative modification and that upon SWMPO approval, the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming notify the FHWA Maryland Division of this administrative modification.

SUMMARY

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) is requesting SWMPO administratively modify the 2019-2022 SWMPO TIP.

ANALYSIS

Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Areawide (SWMPO 4) – This modification reflects the addition of \$175,000 to FY 2019-2022 SWMPO TIP preliminary engineering for SWMPO 4. This modification ensures the FY 2019-2022 SWMPO TIP reflects MDOT SHA’s updated programmed bridge replacement and rehabilitation project expenditures in FY 2019-2022. Per the October 29, 2014, memorandum of understanding executed by MDOT and the Federal Highway Administration, this action is eligible to be processed as an administrative modification as SWMPO 4 is a \$10 million-plus project and this action constitutes an increase in total funding no greater than 20 percent of existing programmed funding.

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The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report document MDOT SHA's modifications with respect to funding for the above project. This action does not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The modified funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2019-2024 Consolidated Transportation Program (<http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/Index.html>) and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/STIP_TIP/STIPandTIP.html).

Please be advised of these modifications to the FY 2019-2022 SWMPO TIP and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP to reflect the funding information provided in the attachments.
