Dear Mr. Murrill and Ms. Crews:

The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2022 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board (BRTB) FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This TIP was approved by the BRTB on July 23, 2019. Subsequently, the FTA and FHWA found that the financial information needed to support a fiscal constraint determination was complete, and that the conformity determination was performed in accordance with the Transportation Conformity Rule requirements. The MDOT has assigned Control #19-14 for this amendment.

Federal regulations require Metropolitan Transportation Plans (MTPs), Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs), and Statewide Transportation Improvement Programs (STIPs) to be "fiscally constrained." The following table provides a reconciliation of the FY 2019-2022 STIP for the inclusion of the BRTB FY 2020-2023 TIP.
