
Dear Ms. Murphy:

We have completed our review of the State request (MDOT Control # 19-18) to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and FY 2019-2024 National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Specifically, the STIP/TIP is being amended to add federal funds for MD 212A Urban Reconstruction at Beltsville. 
Dear Ms. Murphy:
