This administrative modification reflects the addition of $\$ 6.45$ million in State and STBG funds for preliminary engineering, right-of-way, and construction phases. These funds include $\$ 0.96$ million in funds for the preliminary engineering phase ( $\$ 0.02$ million in State funds for FY 2019, $\$ 0.90$ million in STBG funds for FY 2019, and $\$ 0.04$ million in STBG funds for FY 2020 ), $\$ 0.20$ million in State funds for the right-of-way phase ( $\$ 0.14$ million for FY 2019 and $\$ 0.06$ million for FY 2020), $\$ 1.38$ million in State funds for the construction phase ( $\$ 0.001$ million for FY 2019 , $\$ 0.40$ million for FY 2021, $\$ 0.48$ million for FY 2022, $\$ 0.28$ million for FY 2023, and $\$ 0.22$ million for FY 2024), and $\$ 3.91$ million STBG funds for the construction phase ( $\$ 1.91$ million for FY 2022 , $\$ 1.13$ million for FY 2023, and $\$ 0.87$ million for FY 2024). This amendment also reflects the subtraction of $\$ 2.45$ million in State and STBG funds for right of way and construction phases. These funds include $\$ 0.13$ million in State right-of-way funds ( $\$ 0.06$ million for $F Y 2021, \$ 0.01$ million for FY 2022, and $\$ 0.06$ million for FY 2023), $\$ 0.43$ million in State funds for construction for FY 2020 , and $\$ 1.89$ million in STPG construction funds ( $\$ 1.50$ million for FY 2020 and $\$ 0.39$ million for FY 2021).

This amendment reflects the addition of $\$ 8.7$ million in State and STBG funds for preliminary engineering, right-of-way, and construction phases. These funds include $\$ 0.080$ million in funds for the preliminary engineering phase ( $\$ 0.022$ million in State funds for FY 2020 and $\$ 0.058$ million in STBG funds for FY2020), $\$ 0.077$ million in State funds for the right-of-way phase ( $\$ 0.012$ million for FY 2022 and $\$ 0.065$ million for FY 2023), $\$ 1.3$ million in State funds for the construction phase ( $\$ 0.1$ million for $\mathrm{FY} 2021, \$ 0.6$ million for FY 2022, $\$ 0.3$ million for FY 23 , and $\$ 0.3$ million), and $\$ 7.2$ million in STBG funds for the construction phase ( $\$ 2.3$ million for FY 2021, $\$ 2.4$ million for FY 2022, $\$ 1.4$ million for FY 2023, and $\$ 1.1$ million for FY 2024). This amendment also reflects the reduction of State right-of-way funds from $\$ 0.5$ million to $\$ 0.4$ million for FY 2019, from $\$ 0.5$ million to $\$ 0.2$ million for FY 2020, and from $\$ 0.3$ million to $\$ 0.05$ in FY 2021. Reduction of State construction funds from $\$ 0.9$ million to $\$ 0.8$ million for $F Y 2020$ and STBG funds from $\$ 3.6$ million to $\$ 3.1$ million for FY 2020. Subtract $\$ 4.3$ million in STBG right-of-way funds ( $\$ 1.5$ million for $F Y$ 2019, $\$ 1.7$ million for FY 2020, and $\$ 1.1$ million for FY 2021) and $\$ 0.8$ million in construction funds ( $\$ 0.2$ million in State funds for FY 2019 and $\$ 0.6$ million in STBG funds for FY2019).

## SUMMARY

On November 1, 2019, Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Department of Transportation Planning (MWCOG DTP) staff approved the following one MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA)-requested administrative modification to the FY 2019-2024 TPB TIP.

#### Abstract

ANALYSIS MD 212 A Urban Reconstruction (TPB 6529 MC \#19-18 09/24/2019) - This modification reflects the addition of $\$ 957,000$ to FY 2019-2024 TPB TIP planning/design funding, the addition of $\$ 77,000$ to FY 2019-2024 right-of-way acquisition funding, and the addition of $\$ 2,966,000$ to FY 2019-2024 TPB TIP construction funding for TPB 6529 MC \#19-18 09/24/2019. This modification, which shifts previously programmed funds and adds new funds in FY 2019-2024, ensures the FY 2019-2024 TPB TIP reflects MDOT SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule in FY 2019-2024. This project's total cost is increasing from $\$ 22$ million to $\$ 25$ million. Per the October 29, 2014

memorandum of understanding executed by MDOT and the FHWA, this action is eligible to be processed as an administrative modification as TPB 6529 MC \#19-18 09/24/2019 is a $\$ 10$ million-plus project and this action constitutes an increase in total funding no greater than 20 percent of existing total project cost. The MDOT SHA anticipates beginning construction in the Spring of 2020 and opening improvements to traffic in the Fall of 2021.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested modification with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The modified funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2019-2024 Consolidated Transportation Program (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/ Index.html) and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/ STIP_TIP/STIPandTIP.html).
