The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby modifies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 – 2022 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) This modification reflects the decrease in Section 5311 funding to the statewide transit portion of the STIP. The MDOT has designated this administrative modification as Control #19-40.

This administrative modification specifically decreases Section 5311 funding to Ocean City Transit by \$2,400,000. These funds assist with construction and annual preventative maintenance. The supporting documentation is attached.

SUBJECT: Administrative Modification to the FY 2019-2022 STIP

MDOT MTA is requesting an administrative modification to the FY 2019-2022 STIP for capital assistance, STIP ID # MTA-2019-02. MDOT MTA is decreasing Section 5311 Federal funding in the amount of \$2.4M. This discrepancy can be attributed to estimated funding compared to actual need.

This will fund construction for the Ocean City facility and annual preventative maintenance throughout the region.

The proposed action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which continues to be fiscally constrained.
