The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 – 2022 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). This new project amendment reflects the addition \$3M in federal funding to the statewide highway portion of the STIP for engineering and construction to replace the MD 6 Persimmon Creek Bridge (SM1511), which Tropical Storm Isaias washed out on August 4, 2020. The total cost of this project is \$3.75M with matching state funding. The MDOT has designated this amendment as Control #19-74 and the supporting documentation is attached.

PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT Office of Planning and Capital Programming approve and forward to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for its approval the following STIP amendment.

SUMMARY

The MDOT State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) hereby requests amendment of the FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP to reflect the following action.

ANALYSIS

MD 6 Persimmon Creek Bridge Replacement (SM1511) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of \$3,750,000 to the FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP for design and construction of a new project. This amendment is necessary to advance design and construction to replace the previous bridge, which Tropical Storm Isaias washed out on August 4, 2020. The MDOT SHA anticipates construction proceeding in the Spring of 2021.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2020-2025 Consolidated Transportation Program (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/CTP/Index.html) and FY 2019-2022 Maryland STIP (http://www.mdot.maryland.gov/newMDOT/Planning/STIP_TIP/STIPandTIP.html).
