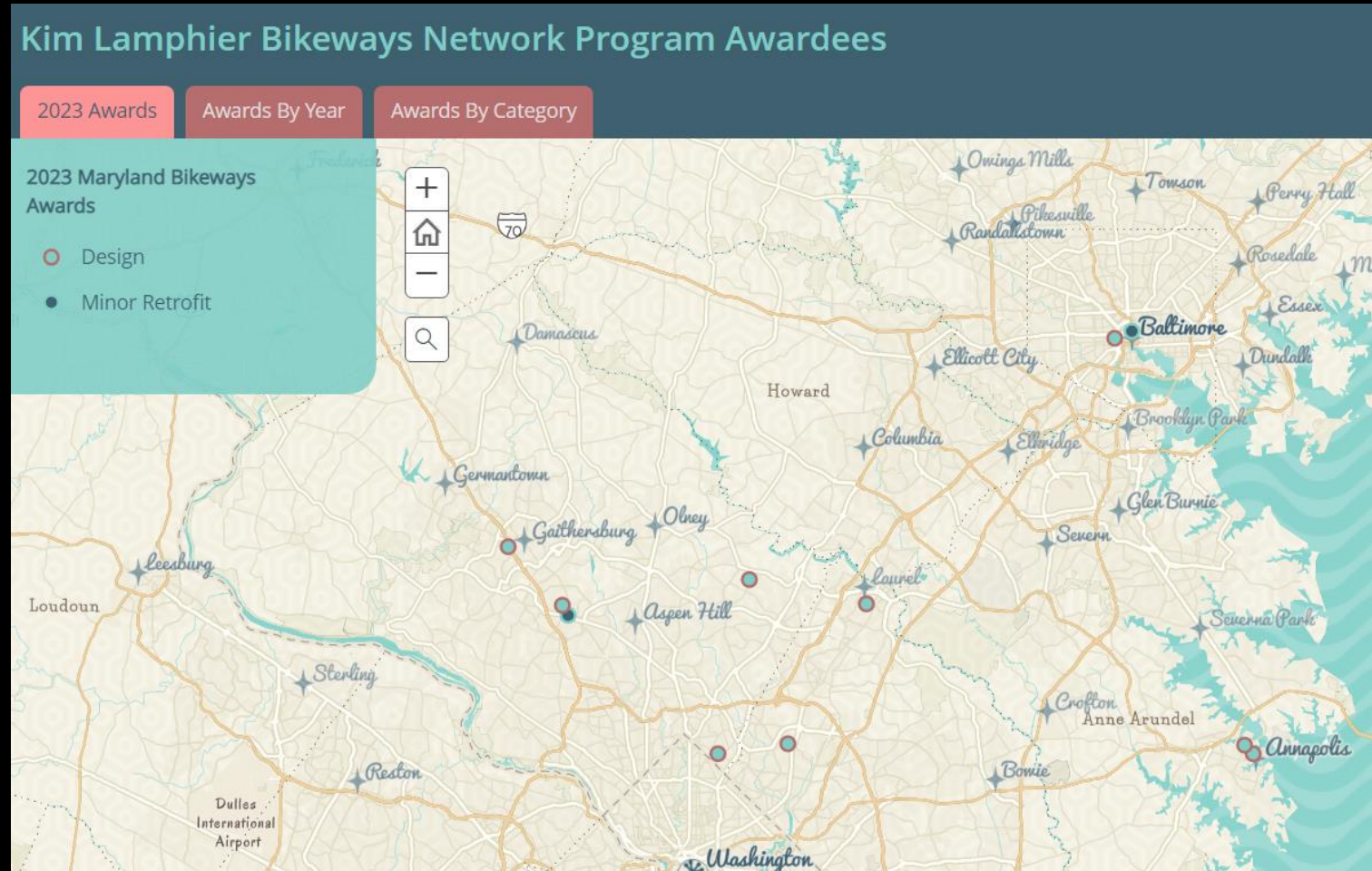

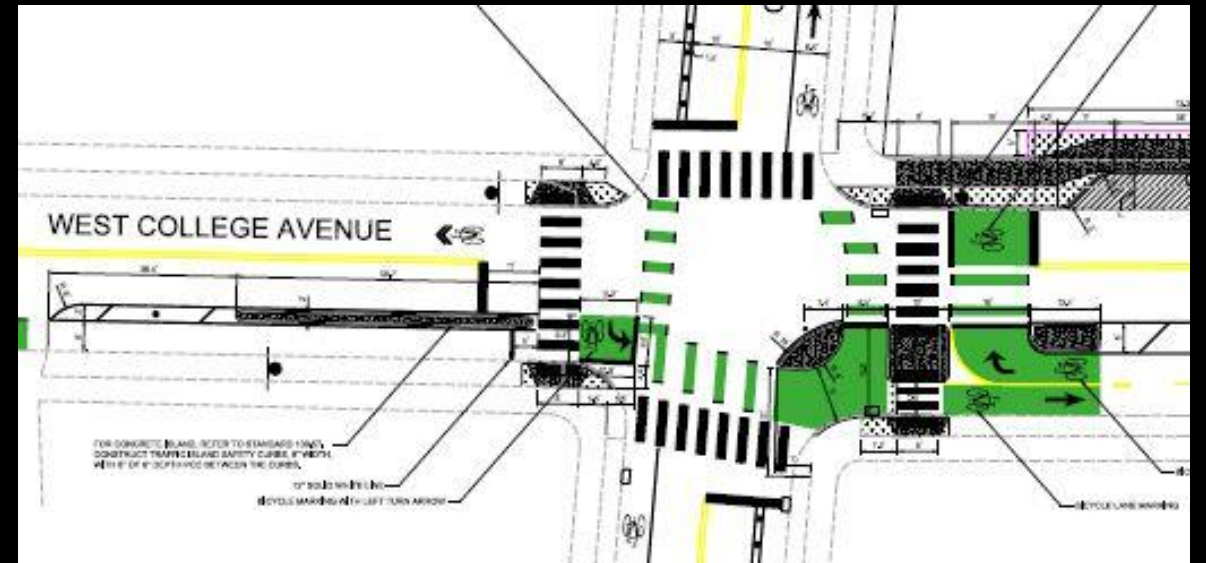
Support planning, design & construction of bicycle transportation projects

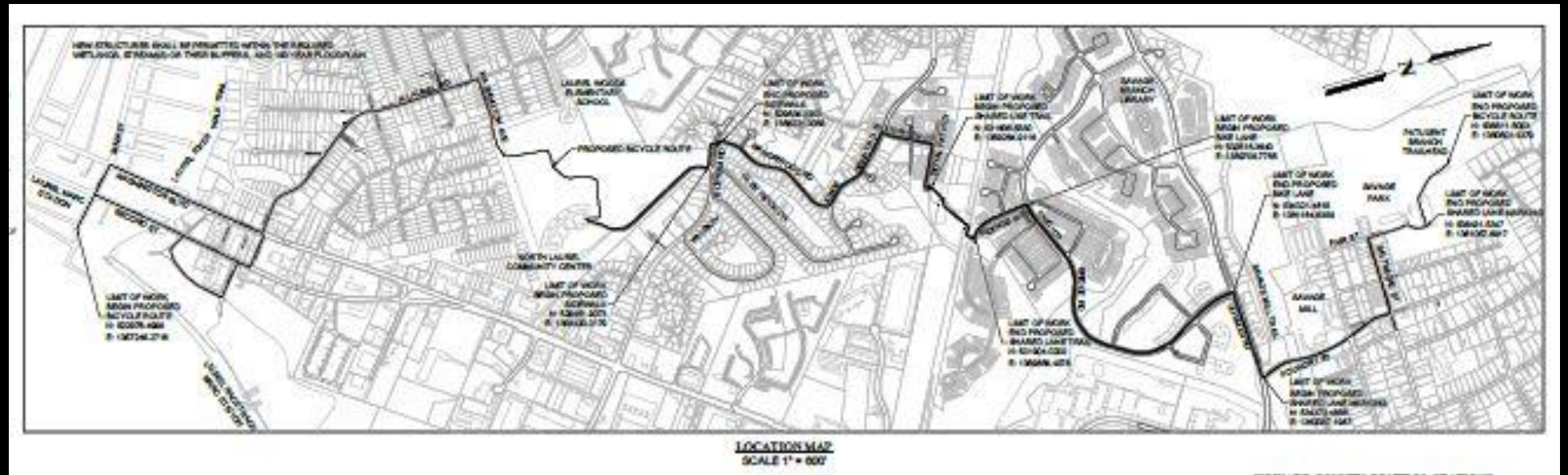
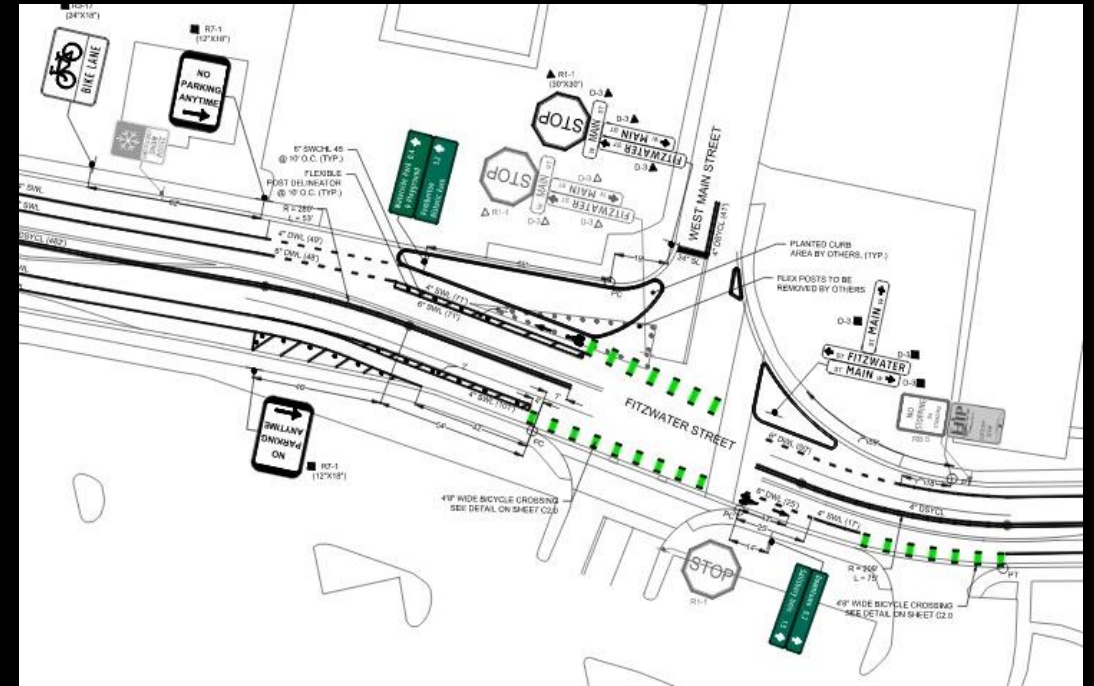

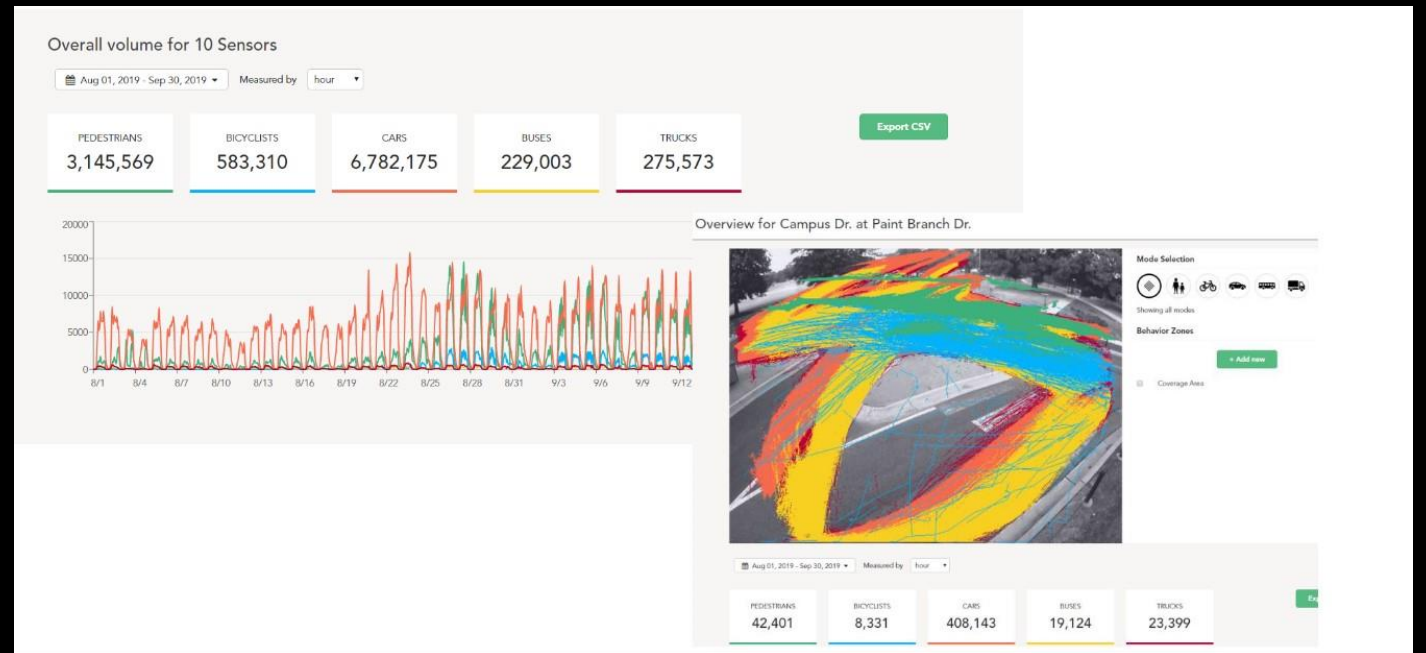
